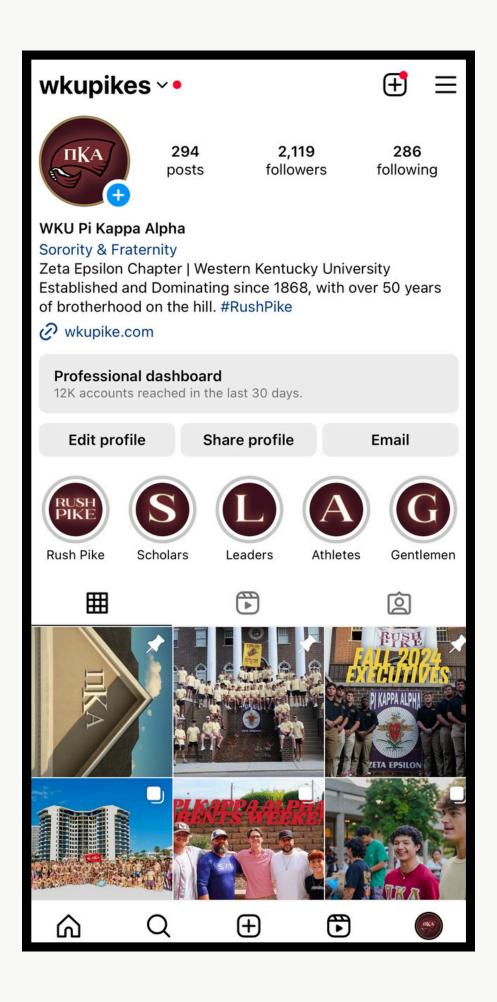
Challenges and Objectives

Challenges

Create content that showcases all aspects of fraternity life through educational posts, active member testimonials, and alumni spotlights to provide a comprehensive view of the chapter.

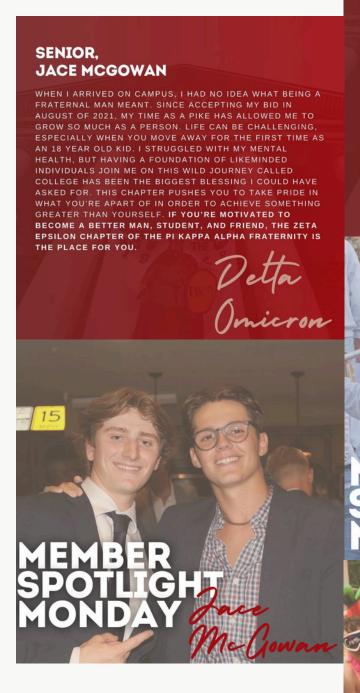


Tone

Adopt an assertive and confident tone of voice that reflects the fraternity's strong, leadership-oriented culture and attitude.

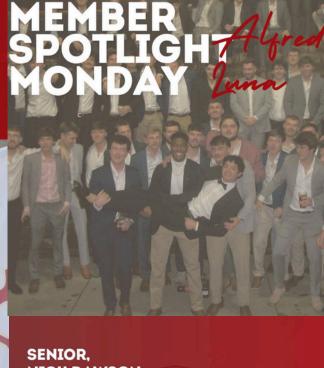
Member Spotlight Mondays

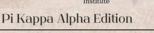

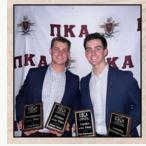

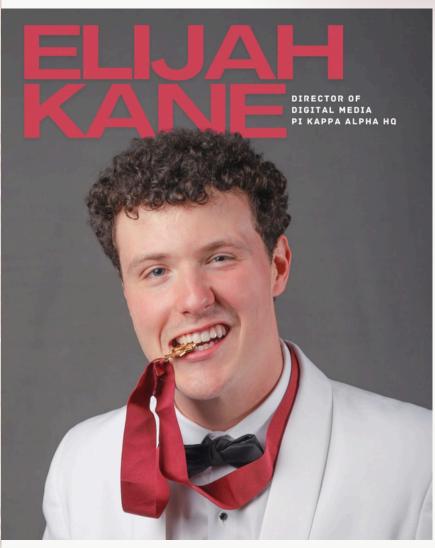
